

**Senate Bill Would Raise PAB Statutory Cap in Connection with P3's**



U.S. Senators John Cornyn (R-TX) and Mark Warner (D-VA) introduced the Building United States Infrastructure and Leveraging Development (BUILD) Act, a bill that would allow more private activity bonds to be used in connection with public-private partnership arrangements for certain infrastructure projects. Specifically, it would raise the federal statutory cap on Private Activity Bonds (PABs) issued by or on behalf of state and local governments for highway and freight improvement projects from \$15 billion to \$20.8 billion.

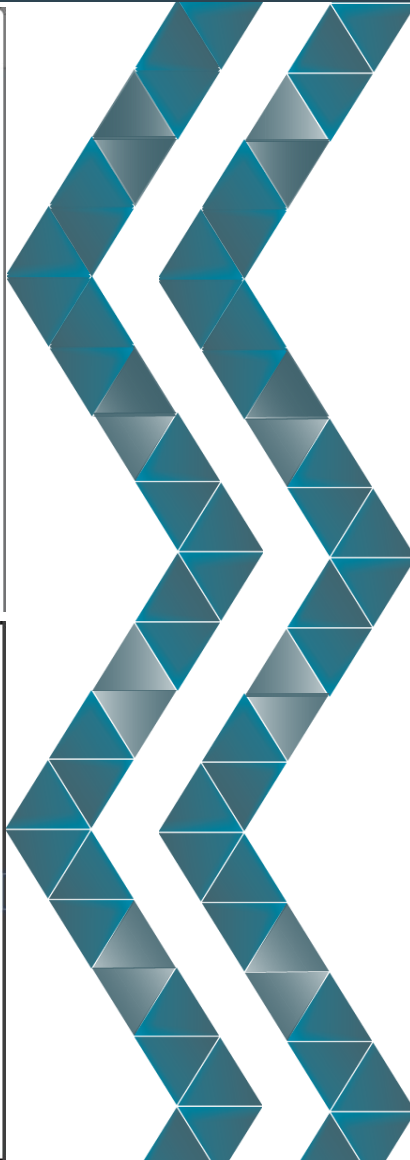

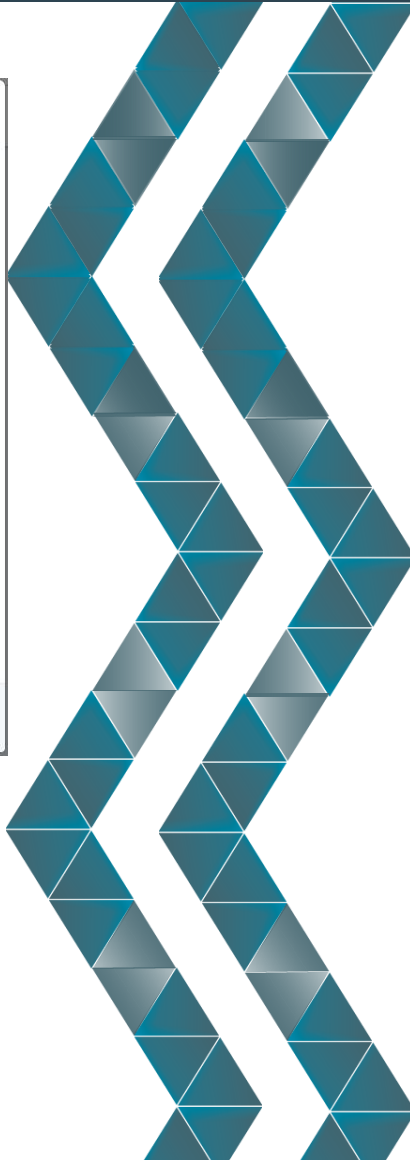

#### House Ways and Means Committee Moves Bills to Redesign the IRS

The House Ways & Means Committee has approved a package of bills to redesign the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and strengthen taxpayer protections. The package includes new avenues for appeals, additional protections against identity theft, and limits on the use of private debt collectors and asset seizures.

The package of bills includes, among other things, updating the IRS's information technology system (H.R. 5445), requiring electronic filing for tax-exempt organizations (H.R. 5443), and modernizing the appeals process (H.R. 5444). The Ways and Means press release is available [here](#).


